

Property Details Inverness Inn, 13996 N Territorial Rd. | Gregory, MI

Don't miss this rare opportunity to own a historic Inn across the street from the <u>Inverness</u> <u>Country Club</u>, near North Lake, and surrounded by natural preserves, trails, lakes, and campgrounds such as Pickney Recreation Area, Crooked Lake Rustic Campground, Blind Lake Campground, Waterloo State Recreation Area, and DTE Energy Foundation Trail. Guenther Homes has 48 homes being built in the area with an additional 40 homes slated for the future. The Inn is the only sit-down restaurant with alcohol in a +/- 10-mile radius.

Centrally located near Chelsea, Dexter, Jackson, and Ann Arbor, the tavern has seating for 186 with 46 additional seats on the patio. It has been recently updated and features an open floor plan, a huge bar, a main dining room within a log cabin with a stunning stone fireplace, and two additional dining areas creating a flexible dining floor plan, potential for private events, and live music.

A large deck overlooks the rear of the property which offers plenty of parking for employees and guests.

The property consists of 3 parcels and is offered at \$459,000 dollars.

The liquor license and furniture, fixtures, and equipment are available separately for \$140,000 dollars.


Property History Inverness Inn, 13996 N Territorial Rd. | Gregory, MI

The Inverness Inn at North Lake was the first community establishment in Dexter Township. The property upon which the Inn stands is part of a land grant to John Glenn, signed by President Andrew Jackson in 1836.

Mary Wright, Glenn's great-granddaughter, established the site as a trading post of sorts in 1907. The original building still stands and is home to the tavern and Moose's log cabin was added to the original structure in the late 1970s.

North Territorial Road, was originally a horse trail and later developed as a route used by coaches and vehicles traveling to Jackson Michigan, and beyond to the "North Territories".

Mr. Douglas Fraser developed the land surrounding the Inn during the 1920s, known as Park Law Subdivision this development included homes, cottages, beaches, athletic fields, and the Inverness County Club and Golf Course.

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










Demographics 2 Mile Radius




